To operate a centre of excellence where children who have lost either one or both parents, or who are considered vulnerable and in need of Christian assistance, can receive a free, quality, Protestant Christian education from Nursery School through to Primary School and Secondary School, in a loving, nurturing, safe, attractive, clean and hygienic environment.

To achieve this, Orbus needs to establish income-generating activities on this site and all staff, volunteers, parents and guardians are required to assist in any way possible to ensure these activities are successful, productive and profitable.

For the Orbus Mission to be fulfilled, over a long period of time, every staff member, volunteer, parent, guardian, local church, presbytery, community member and student needs to be diligent in their honesty, generosity, selflessness, and love for others (especially for orphans and vulnerable children and the poor).

Bible study is to be conducted every morning for all staff and volunteers prior to the start of classes to assist in conveying the Christian truths to these needy children. Prayer, Bible readings, Christian songs, and Bible memory verses, including the compulsory memorising of the 10 Commandments in Chichewa and English by every Orbus student, are required daily activities in every Orbus class.

Corrupt practices and theft of any sort from the Orbus Centre or property in any form should be reported to admin@orbusafrica.org, the CCAP Blantyre Synod or direct to the Police. Every incidence of corruption and theft is to be prosecuted with no exception. The only way these children can receive a free education here is if there is no corruption or theft of resources designated for this Mission. Corruption ruins lives in many ways. Please be diligent in your honesty, your encouragement of others to be honest and in your good example to others. Once prosecuted, a person loses his/her job, reputation, future employment opportunities and their family suffers. "Do not steal. Do not lie. Do not deceive one another." (Leviticus 19:11)
